## Picasso Museum

A professional guide will take you through the most important works in the museum for one hour.

The Picasso museum is very rich in regard to work from the formative years in the life of the artist; it is practically exhaustive up to the Blue Period. The Museum also houses an important representation of works from 1917, and the series Las Meninas (1957) as well as a comprehensive print collection.

The Picasso Museum occupies five large town houses or palaces on the street carrer de Montcada. The original palaces date from the 13th-15th centuries, undergoing major refurbishments over time, the most important in the 18th century.

The palaces are a good example of Catalan civic gothic style. They have a common structure surrounding a courtyard with access to the main floor via an outdoor open stairway.

The Museu Picasso in Barcelona was the first and only museum to be set up on the artist's express wish. It opened its doors in 1963.

If you'd like to have a scuba diving adventure and enjoy a unique experience, L'Aquàrium has organised exactly what you've been looking for. Become a scuba diver for a day, and when you're underwater in the Oceanarium, you'll have sharks and thousands of fish swimming beside you.

### You don't need any previous diving experience.


Your adventure as a scuba diver begins with your first dive. You'll learn all about hand signals, using a regulator and breathing underwater, and practise buoyancy control and moving around by means of underwater rings.

Then it's time for L'Aquàrium de Barcelona's main tank. From an observation platform and with one of L'Aquàrium's instructors by your side, and while breathing underwater, you'll be able to observe all of our guests: sharks, rays, moray eels, moonfish, etc.

What to expect when you arrive:

- The instructor who welcomes all of the participants will be with you for the whole activity.
- You'll learn scuba diving techniques on your first dive.
- You'll observe the sharks and fish from an underwater platform inside the Oceanarium.
- You'll be using scuba diving equipment and clothing in your size.
- You'll be covered by a one-day insurance policy.
- You can invite a person to accompany you and share this unique experience. He or she can enter free-of-charge to take photos (without flash) and wave to you.

## Museu Nacional d'Art de Catalunya MNAC (National Art Museum of Catalonia)

The Museu Nacional d'Art de Catalunya is located in the Palau Nacional of Montjuïc, constructed for the International Exposition of 1929. In 1934 it opened its doors as the Museu d'Art de Catalunya and later became the MNAC, as it is known nowadays.

During this guided visit you will see the best collection of Romanesque mural painting in the world and the most representative artists of Catalan Modernism, such as Gaudí or Casas. Gothic art, great European Renaissance and Baroque painters, for example Tiziano or Velázquez, and the collection of photography.

The museum is located on the hill of Montjuïc, a privileged setting from which you can enjoy magnificent and unique views of Barcelona.

## Montjuïc Cemetery

The Cemeteries Route is an initiative headed by Cementiris de Barcelona with the aim of promoting its burial grounds. It is a reminder that Barcelona is not just one but many cities. The route provides a journey through the past and present, where the visitor will find historical, famous and heroic characters as well as tales of wealth and poverty, love and death. The Route is also part of the European Cemeteries Route, recognised by the Council of Europe as a Cultural Route since 2010.

The Montjuïc Cemetery Route is focused on the years 1883 to 1936 and includes 37 tombs, mostly in the Modernist style. It is designed to display the cultural wealth of the burial ground, combining tombs of both artistic and historical interest.

The Fossar de la Pedrera (literally, Cemetery of the Quarry) is an area dedicated to the memory of the victims of the repression and air-raids by Francisco Franco's armed forces. In the Fossar is the tomb of the Catalan President Lluís Companys, among other monuments. It also contains the mortal remains of the victims of the repression in the rear and the air-raids during the Civil War and those of a large number of people shot in Barcelona in the post-war period.

## Park Güell + Sagrada Familia

### PARK GÜELL

In 1900, Gaudí was given the assignment by Eusebi Güell of designing Park Güell. Güell understood better than any of his contemporaries the meaning of Gaudí's architecture. The relationship between the two men was not simply that of an artist and his patron, but a real story of friendship.

For many years the Güell family lived in the large family house (now a school) that stood on the land where the development was located, while Gaudí lived in one of the two houses that were built there.

In the businessman's own lifetime, the park was already considered to be one of Barcelona's great tourist attractions, and the large square was often let for staging Catalanist events, traditional Catalan sardana dancing and other civic and social events.

### SAGRADA FAMILIA

The Sagrada Familia, designed by Antoni Gaudí (1852-1926) is a symbolic expression in stone of the Christian faith. In this temple, an exaltation of the Family of Nazareth as a model for a united family, Christians, especially Roman Catholics, can recognise the tenets of their faith. Likewise, those who profess a different faith or none at all can find in it the keys for understanding the Christian religion: the history of the Church, the Sacred Scriptures, the tradition of dedication to the Saints, Christian doctrine and worship.

The Sagrada Familia is an international centre for spirituality which, in an exceptional setting, invites people of all backgrounds and faiths to share in a sense of life based on love, harmony, good, generosity and peace.
